A Scout is ready for a Board of Review when the Scout has completed all the requirements for a rank and has completed their Scoutmaster conference.

• How does a Scout request a Board of Review? In person if it's during a scout meeting or send an email to borcoordinator.troop9@gmail.com.

Your email needs to simply say:

• What Should a Scout wear to a Board of Review?

Wear your full Class A uniform with a neckerchief and closed-toe shoes. Make sure your shirttail is tucked in. Look sharp!

• How Should a Scout Prepare for a Board of Review?

Make sure you can recite the Scout Oath and Scout Law. Be ready to share your Scouting experiences, talk about any challenges, discuss merit badges you have earned or are working on, and what leadership roles you have held or would like to achieve.

- What Should You Bring to a Board of Review? Scout book and water bottle.
- What Should You Do When You Get to the Board of Review?

Introduce yourself to the adult leaders, explain what rank you are completing, then recite the Scout Oath, Law, and Motto.

• Should I be nervous about the Board of Review?

No, it's normal to feel a little nervous at your first Board of Review. Try to be confident and keep a positive attitude. You can do it!
